

Abstracts to be presented

Abstracts to be presented during the 12th EFSMA Congress of Sports Medicine should be related with disciplines such as basic sciences, clinical sciences, epidemiology, public health, and applied sciences. An author can submit a maximum of one abstract as the presenting author. It is possible to appear as a co-author on other abstracts but not on more than three abstracts. Please note that after your submission has been made, further changes cannot be accepted.

Participation formats

- Oral presentation.
- Poster presentation.

Abstract submission

- Abstracts should be submitted following the link **Send an Abstract** (we only accept online abstract submissions) by 20th May 2023. Abstracts sent by email will not be accepted.

Abstracts preparation

- **Title.** The title should be concise, specific and relevant, about 200 characters maximum (including spaces). Please do not include abbreviated or short forms in the title.
- **Author list and affiliations.** Authors' full first and last names must be provided. The PubMed/MEDLINE standard format is used for affiliations: complete address information including university, institute, clinic, hospital, city, state/province, and country. At least one author should be designated as the corresponding author, and their email address and other details should be included at the end of the **Send an Abstract** section.
- **Abstract.** The abstract should be a total of about 3000 characters maximum (including spaces and references). The abstract should be a single paragraph and should follow the style of structured abstracts: 1) Introduction. Place the question addressed in a broad context and highlight the purpose of the study, 2) Methods. Describe briefly the main methods or treatments applied. Include any relevant preregistration numbers, and species and strains of any animals used. 3) Results. Summarize the article's main findings, and 4) Conclusion. Indicate the main conclusions or interpretations.
- **Keywords.** Three to ten relevant keywords should be added after the abstract. We recommend that the keywords are specific to the article, yet reasonably common within the subject discipline.
- **Funding.** All sources of funding of the study should be disclosed.

Important note

- Only abstracts in English language will be accepted.
- Abstracts should not be published before submission to the 12th EFSMA Congress of Sports Medicine.
- All accepted abstracts will be published in the proceedings of the Abstract Supplement of 12th EFSMA Congress of Sports Medicine, provided that the presenting author has paid the registration fee by 31st July 2023 to guarantee publication of abstract in the Abstract Supplement of the EFSMA. Not paying the registration fee by 31st July 2023 will result in exclusion from the scientific programme and from the Abstract Supplement of the EFSMA.
